Students are given opportunities to foster their relationship with God, to grow intellectually, to develop their individual gifts, and to be catalysts for the promotion of justice locally, nationally and globally.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Established in 1964, La Reina High School is a private Catholic college preparatory school for girls in grades 7 through 12. The school is sponsored by the Sisters of Notre Dame. It is fully accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges and the Western Catholic Education Association. Current enrollment is 580 students with an average class size of 25. Admission of students is highly selective.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

La Reina offers a comprehensive, college preparatory program with graduation requirements that reflect the standards for admission to the University of California. Students earn five credits for each semester of study. The required number of credits in each department is given below:

HONORS DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

To earn an honors diploma, students must have a minimum GPA of 3.5 and take 40 additional credits in upper division and honors or AP classes. Those credits must be earned in one or more of the following departments: English, Foreign Language, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies or Fine Arts (AP only). This additional coursework must be taken at La Reina High School in grades 9 through 12.

Of those students, twenty-seven are AP scholars, eleven are AP Scholars with Honors, twenty-five are AP Scholars with Distinction and two are AP National Scholars. Sixty-three percent of the students earned a grade of 4 or 5.
