Regents Win Mock Trial World Championship

The LRHS Mock Trial Team won the 2011 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP at the Empire City Mock Trial Invitational Tournament yesterday!

They won trials against teams from Georgia, Ireland, Oregon, and California. The final match, scored by a panel of 13 judges, found the LRHS plaintiff team competing against the defense team from Wyoming Seminary in Pennsylvania.

The tournament included 16 state champions (including LRHS, 2011 California state champions), 6 international teams and 34 at-large teams.

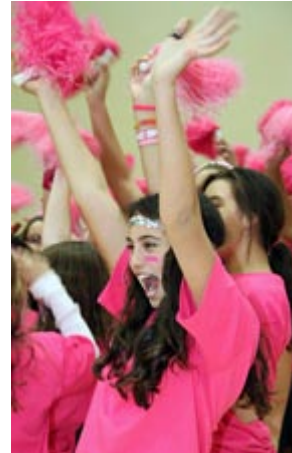
Admissions Update
