COURSE DESCRIPTIONS BY GRADES:

5th and 6th Grade Offerings:

Study Skills:

This course will cover techniques for becoming a more successful student. Topics covered will include goal setting, time management, organizational skills, research gathering, and the Cornell note taking method.

Writing Lab:

Students refine and build upon previously learned knowledge and skills in increasingly complex multiple-paragraph essays. Essays will contain formal introductions, supporting evidence, and conclusions.

Marvelous Math:

This course is designed to help students gain confidence in their mathematics ability by providing practice in the computation of whole numbers, decimals, and fractions.

Fitness Fun:

La Reina athletics introduces a comprehensive physical education enrichment class. The class will include indoor and outdoor soccer, basketball, volleyball, and tennis.

Art:

This course allows students to create many different forms of art to help them expand their individual talents. No prior art experience needed.

Please note: La Reina's ability to offer the courses listed above depends on sufficient enrollment. 7th and 8th Grade Offerings:

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9th and 10th Offerings

Writing Lab:

This course will focus on the structural foundation needed to write strong, analytical paragraphs. Students entering la Reina for the ninth or tenth grades will have an opportunity to become familiar with the La Reina writing program.

Algebra 1 Review:

This is a review course of Algebra I for students in grades 9-10, who have already completed Algebra I, but who need reinforcement of basic Algebra skills. This course is also a great review of algebraic concepts before taking Algebra II/Trigonometry.

French Language and Culture:

Discover the fun of the French language. This course is designed as an introduction to the French language and culture. Students will learn about basic structures and pronunciation of French in the context of short stories, drama play, songs, games, and more. We will explore a variety of beginner topics including school life, food, family and friends, in a fun and interactive way.
