PERIOD I:

5th - 6th Grade: Marvelous Math June 15 – June 26

As a preliminary course to the study of algebra, this course is a review of basic arithmetic, the real number system and its applications in solving and graphing equations and inequalities. Other topics include polynomials and rational and irrational numbers.

9th - 10th Grade: Writing Lab
