Please know that the La Reina Administration is being proactive and vigilant when monitoring all updates regarding COVID-19 (Coronavirus). As we continue to monitor, it is important we practice thoughtful media consumption. It is our goal to model composure and calm as school leaders.

Our students' health and well-being are our priority at La Reina. As such, The Centers for Disease Control (<u>CDC</u>), the World Health Organization (<u>WHO</u>), Ventura County Public Health (<u>VCHCA</u>), and the California Department of Public Health (<u>CDPH</u>) are the experts on whom we will rely for the best information.

At this time, school will continue as scheduled. We will continue to enact preventative measures on campus, including but not limited to the following:

- Washing hands with soap and water.
- Avoiding touching eyes, nose or mouth with unwashed hands.
- Advising the use of "respiratory etiquette" Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue or your elbow.
- Avoiding close contact with people who are sick.
- Staying away from work, school or other people if you become sick with respiratory symptoms like fever and cough.
- Following guidance from public health officials.
- If symptoms become more severe (e.g. high fever or difficulty breathing), students, teachers, and staff should seek medical care.
- Weekly *electrostatic cleaning* of all classrooms, offices, bathrooms, and public areas.
